




# Spiritual Care Plan for Nurses - "Blessed Time" Spiritual-Growth Groups

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# **Objective**

- Due to the high stress and tension cause many nurses to resign and decrease the stability of nurse team.
- The purpose of this plan is to enable nurses to have spiritual growth and have better awareness of patients' spiritual need.

### Intervention

- In 2017, we started in a particular surgical ward.
- Through two years of small fixed group interaction of the whole nurse team in a comfort coffee shop.
- We provide a safe environment for nurse to take care of their spiritual needs, they increase the ability of self-awareness and self-care.

Every month, they learn reflective listening and empathy by using different expressive art tools.(cards, drawing and writing)


#### 2-hour Rundown

    - 9. I will recommend other staff to come and join
- 10. This activity increases the belonging to the nurse team
  - 11. I want to join the next phase in the off-duty time




# **Qualitative Description**

# Conclusion

- Through the small group interaction after two-year spiritual plan, participants are able to self care and awareness.
- After two years, the spiritual groups increase the stability and decrease the resignation of the nurse team.
