Jewish Heritage Tour

Until the outbreak of World War II, Poland was an important Jewish cultural and spiritual centre. Warsaw's Jewish population was then about 400.000, which was almost one third of the city's total. The vast majority of this strong Jewish community perished during the Holocaust. However, traces of the original Jewish community remain. The tour includes: Nozyk Synagogue – devastated during occupation and renovated after the war, serves all believers to this very day; Okopowa Jewish Cemetery – the largest in Warsaw founded at the beginning of the 19th century; Warsaw Ghetto area – including the site of the bunker on Miła Street; the monumental Memorial of the Heroes of the Warsaw Ghetto; the Umschlagplatz; the Museum of the History of the Polish Jews presenting special exhibitions, displays, documents and artefacts.

ROYAL CASTLE – a national monument of Polish history, official royal residence since 1596. The royal halls and chambers are furnished with historic mementoes and precious works of art. In its long history the Royal Castle was repeatedly devastated and plundered by Swedish, Brandenburgian, German, and Russian armies. After the devastation by the Nazis during the Warsaw Uprising, the Castle was rebuilt and reconstructed. In 1980, Royal Castle, together with the Old Town was added to the UNESCO World Heritage List. Today it is an historical and national monument, and is listed as a national museum.

WILANOW – The Polish Versailles is a wonderful baroque palace and a place of great beauty, both inside and out. One will have the opportunity to stroll through the beautiful garden and park. 'Villa Nova' was established in XVII and served as the royal summer residence of King Jan III Sobieski, the famous conqueror of the Turks at the battle of Vienna in 1683. He was a most colourful person of 17th Century Poland, a skilful army leader, accomplished diplomat and author of beautiful love letters written to Marie Cassimere, his wife. Today, the palace houses a great collection of historic Polish portrait paintings and European silver.
